Wilmington College is an independent, co-educational, four-year, career-oriented, liberal arts college in southwestern Ohio. Founded in 1870 by the Religion Society of Friends (Quakers) in Wilmington, Ohio, the College is within an hour's drive of Cincinnati, Dayton and Columbus, three of Ohio's major cities. There are approximately 1,000 students on the main campus and its Blue Ash campus near Cincinnati. Wilmington College offers 25 majors plus 20 additional areas of study. Among the most popular majors are athletic training, sport management, agriculture, education, business administration, biology, mathematics, and criminal justice.



**The Austin E. Knowlton
Memorial Scholarship**

About Austin E. Knowlton

Austin E. "Dutch" Knowlton was the owner and Chairman of the Knowlton Construction Company, an organization started in Bellfontaine, Ohio in 1937



"Dutch" Knowlton was responsible for over 600 major and significant construction projects throughout Ohio and the Midwest – most of which were education buildings, hospitals, and libraries. Established in his name, the Austin E. Knowlton Foundation was created in 1981 "...to promote and advance higher education in the United States, and to provide direct grants and contributions to qualified colleges and universities." Mr. Knowlton became an avid sportsman with a 50 year interest in saddle bred horses. He was a founding partner and served as Chairman of the Cincinnati Bengals, and held significant ownership interest in the Cincinnati Reds for many years.

He also was a leading philanthropist, and established this Memorial Scholarship at Wilmington College to benefit students from Ohio, preferably originating from his own Logan County.

Wilmington College has a spot reserved for you! You may be eligible for a \$5,000 scholarship from the Austin E. Knowlton Foundation.

The Austin E. Knowlton Foundation of Cincinnati has established a scholarship fund at Wilmington College for Logan County Ohio high school graduates. Each Austin E. Knowlton Memorial Scholarship will provide \$5,000 to a Wilmington College Freshman who meets the following qualifications:

- Is a resident of Logan County Ohio and/or graduated from a Logan County high school, and
- Is interested in majoring in mathematics or a related field.

The Austin E. Knowlton Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

- Each scholarship will be at least \$5,000, regardless of financial need,
- First preference will be Logan County Ohio residents -- if there are no applicants from Logan County, eligible applications from surrounding Ohio counties will be considered,
- Preference will be given to students interested in majoring in Math with secondary consideration to other math related fields, at the discretion of the scholarship selection committee.
- All Knowlton scholarships are eligible to be renewed annually,

- Consistent with Wilmington College financial aid policy, the Knowlton Scholarship can be combined with other financial aid, however the entire package may not exceed full tuition.
