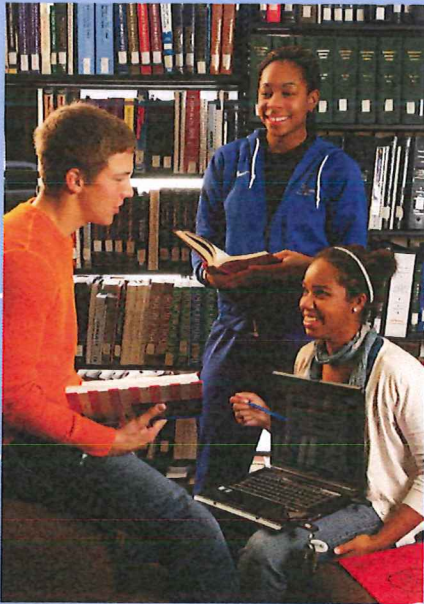

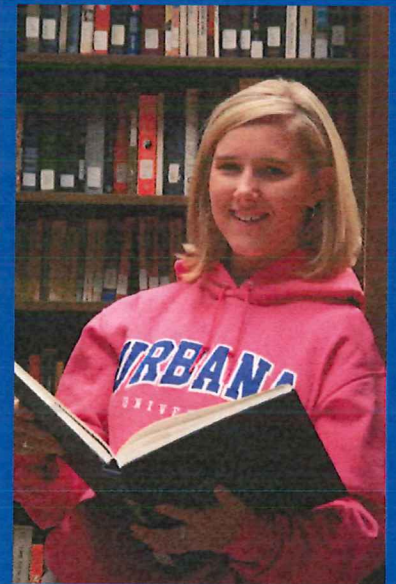

About Austin E. Knowlton

Austin E. "Dutch" Knowlton was the owner and chairman of the Knowlton Construction Company, an organization started in Bellefontaine, Ohio in 1937 and whose predecessors date back to 1906.



Knowlton, through his company, was responsible for over 600 major and significant construction projects throughout Ohio and the Midwest, including school buildings, hospitals, and libraries.

Knowlton was a 1927 graduate of Bellefontaine High School and graduated from The Ohio State University in 1931, where he received a Bachelor of Science in architectural engineering. He became an avid sportsman with a 50-year interest in saddle bred horses, an original founding partnership in the Cincinnati Bengals where he served as chairman, a major ownership interest for many years in the Cincinnati Reds, and a trusteeship of the Little Brown Jug Society for harness racing in Delaware, Ohio.

Knowlton was also a leading philanthropist with The Ohio State School of Architecture, named in his honor.



Austin E. Knowlton Memorial Scholarship

During his lifetime, Knowlton established the Austin E. Knowlton Foundation with funding for the Foundation during his lifetime and by the provisions of his will. Purposes of the Foundation include the advancement of higher education and "to provide direct grants and contributions to qualified colleges and universities".

The trustees of the Foundation, in carrying out the direction of Knowlton, have established the Austin E. Knowlton Memorial Scholarship at

Urbana University. The scholarship grants are subject to the following provisions:

- Applicants must be residents of Logan County, Ohio - only if there are no applicants from Logan County shall other Ohio residents be eligible.
- One scholarship will be reserved for an incoming freshman.
- Priority shall be given to students who are interested in a career in architecture.
